Mr. Brown discussed the budget for the upcoming fiscal year of 2026 / 2027. Budget from last year seems to be going as planned. Some big projects are completed like the splash pad and storm water projects. Mooney Street is the next major project. There will be street, water and sewer

repair done. The plan is to use \$300,000.00 from street, \$200,000.00 water line repairs and \$200,000.00 for sewer to pay for the project.

Rate increases have helped the water department to be in good shape for the next fiscal year. We will be pre paying bonds again this year as we have excess dept service money. The City's growth means we are collecting more for dept service that will go to paying the bonds. The park and storm water fund has used some of the money for the splash pad and storm water projects but both are complete. Over all the city as a healthy budget for the beginning fiscal year. The Skata system may be another project public works is looking to bid this year. Employee raises and LAGERS were discussed.
